Bomme Dinatla is a home-based care organization that was registered in 2004 in the Rustenburg Local Municipality. The organization was started by a group of self-driven women whose dedication pushed them to come up with ways of dealing with the increasing HIV/AIDS and TB Pandemic in the Rustenburg area. The area of focus is Ward 18, which is centered on mines, Viz, Jabula Hostel, Impala Mine, as well as Xstrata refineries. The group of women therefore assists in providing support to all infected and affected by the diseases. One of their main objectives is poverty alleviation; they also started a food garden that has helped with the delivery of food parcels to the needy. They have partnered with different government structures that include; Department of Health, Department of Social Development, Department of Home Affairs, the Child Protection Unit, and the Rustenburg Local Municipality.
