Kekanastad Traditional Mothers Development Organisation (KETRAMODEO) is located in Majaneng, under Tswane Municipality. The organization was established in the early 1970s, by a group of various women during the rule of female chieftain Esther Kekana, current patron of the project. Ketramodeo focuses on the provision of broad-based services and support to the underprivileged in rural areas as well as the promotion of sustainable social, economic and moral advancement of individuals, families and institutions.

Among the many roles that the women have played in the development and improvement of the lives of the Kekanastad community, Ketramodeo has been involved in the following; establishment and building of two crèches (now pre-schools), the building of the Amandebele-Ba-Lebelo Tribal Office, as well as a clinic in the Majaneng area.
