



METSI BOTSHELO PROJECT

Metsi Botshelo Water is an organization based in Dinokana village under Ramotshere Moilwa Municipality; the project focuses on water harvesting. The project was started by two elderly women when they realized that the water from the surrounding mountains -especially during rainy seasons- flooded into people's homes leaving them frustrated as roads were damaged including inhabitants' homes. In the past, efforts to try and control the flow of water were made. The municipality and the community have tried to solve the problem by placing round pipes underground to redirect the water away from the people's homes. However with the building of the roads in the area those pipes have been dug out leaving people with a serious dilemma. The project is assisted by Kgogamasigo Cultural Youth group, another organization based in the region.

Reduced water loss and empowered community on water conservation and environment

- Building canals
- Put colbert and fencing
- Purchasing tools

- Safe environment against rain water
