

Elandskloof Household Water Security

IWRM Objectives – Water security, rainwater harvesting, cooperative governance, capacity building & empowerment

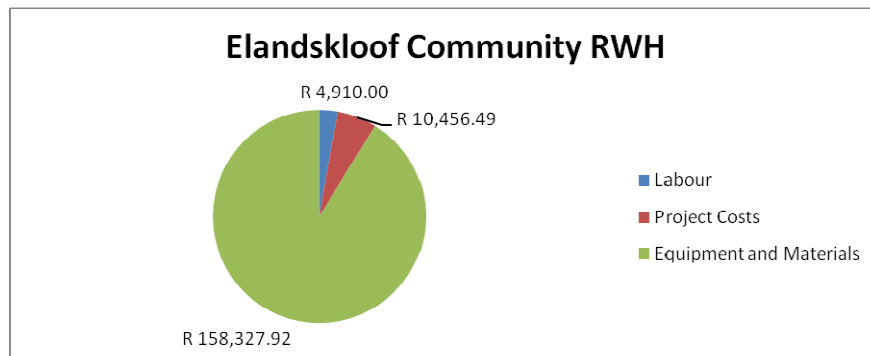


Elandskloof community won the first land restitution case in post-apartheid South Africa. Since resettling on the farm, the community has struggled through many challenges, including lack of water for domestic use. The Elandskloof Community Association approached DWA IWRM to assist them with funding for 2500 litre tanks that could be installed at 78 households to serve as a reservoir and catch rainwater for domestic use.

Financial Information for Elandskloof Community (EL11)

The Elandskloof Community RWH was awarded a contract named IWRMII-OD-EL11-005 in 2008 to the value of R180,608.00. R173,694.41 was spent in the given contract period and the project was closed at the end of June 2009 having reached its objectives.

Of the budget allocated to this group, R158,327.92 was spent on materials and equipment to build the operations, R4,910.00 was allocated to wages and payments for work done on project tasks, and R10,456.49 was claimed to support the project management and administration tasks undertaken by the group.
